On the hill... All-Star Ryan Searle will toe the rubber for game one of the doubleheader. The righty is coming off a win at Brevard County, his first since July 15. The Aussie still boasts the best ground-out-to-air-out ratio amongst starters at 2.16. Against Clearwater, Searle is 0-1 with a 1.93 ERA after three starts. Opposing him will be Jon Velasquez, who will be making his first start of the season against Daytona. Game Two... Oswaldo Martinez will make his second start of the season in nightcap of the twin bill. The righty from Mexico has yet to allow a run to score in his six-plus innings of work with Daytona. Martinez threw three innings of scoreless baseball in a doubleheader start at Tampa last week. He will face off against Tyler Cloyd, another Threshers pitcher yet to appear against the Cubs.

Last Time Out... The Cubs earned the series win with an 8-5 victory over Lakeland. After a Jeramy Laster staked the Flying Tigers to a lead with a two-run homer in the first, Brandon Guyer evened the score with his own two-run blast, his first in of the season. Daytona added three more in the second on three hits and an error. Both teams plated two in the fifth. Lakeland used a home run by Audy Ciriaco. The Cubs did it with timely hitting as Josh Vitters followed a lead off walk and a wild pitch to drive in Nathan Samson. Guyer then brought in Vitters with a two-out single. Daytona pitching combined to strike out twelve batters, giving them 37 K's for the series.

PiOW for Jackson... Daytona starting pitcher Jay Jackson has been brilliant since returning to the Florida State League from Double-A Tennessee. On August 10th, the Furman University product faced the minimum 21 batters through seven scoreless innings of work and struck out four. He followed that up with a victory on August 16th against Dunedin. The right-hander spun six-and-two-thirds innings of shutout baseball and struck out seven. Jackson surrendered just six hits over thirteen-plus innings of work. For his effort, Jackson was awarded the FSL Pitcher of the Week for August 10-23.

All-Stars Depart... Two of Daytona's All-Stars will finish out the 2009 season with Double-A Tennessee. Shortstop Starlin Castro, who was one of the FSL's top hitters, will move up after hitting .302 through 96 games. The All-Star Game MVP led the league with 108 hits, and was tops on the team in runs scored (45) and doubles (17). Catcher Robinson Chirinos departs after hitting .300 in 69 games. He led Daytona in a number of categories, including RBI (47), triples (5), home runs (11) and OPS (946). In their place, the D-Cubs will welcome back infielder Nathan Samson and catcher Mark Reed.

Versus Clearwater Threshers... The Threshers have won six of the first eleven games in the season series with Daytona. Clearwater also owns a 3-2 edge at "The Jack", having won a three-game set in May and splitting a rain shortened series in July. Daytona and Clearwater will play three more games next weekend to wrap up the 2009 season.
